Welcome to Ickenham Hall

You may not realise that you are in the original kitchen of Ickenham Hall (1740). The fireplace is original and although now bricked up, is where all the cooking for the household was done - firstly on an open fire then, in Victorian times, on a large range with ovens.

The Friends of Ickenham Hall is a group of dedicated volunteers working to restore the Hall, as much as is possible, to its former state. Further work is to be done in the Kitchen, for example, to the floor and to furnish it more appropriately. Similar work is being carried out both internally and externally throughout the Hall as and when funds can be raised.

The book sale in this area is part of that fund raising, as are several events through the year. These include the Murder Mystery evenings, the Quizzes, the annual Open Days and the Christmas Concert.
